SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY:

THE HIGHEST FORM OF RELATIONSHIPS (PART 1)

Relationships and friendships are highly spiritual. God is relational—he works through relationships. He works through man to do whatever He will do on earth.

There is nobody you've met that God did not ordain for you to meet, be it your parents or friends. None of them is a mistake. God is a God of purpose and relationships. (Psalm 68:6).

Relationship has four levels, and understanding them determines how far you accomplish or succeed. They are: ${}^-$

- Our relationship with God: This is the first and highest one. God **Our relationship with God:** This is the first and highest one. God expects us to relate to Him as a Father. A father gives identity, provides, protects, lifts and covers. If we do not relate with Him this way, we are not born again. He wants intimacy with us—anytime man is out of intimacy with God, he starts failing. The main reason why Jesus came was to restore our relationship with God. God's presence is man's natural habitat and the only place where one can become all that God has purposed. (Genesis 1:26, 2:7, 2:15, 3: 8, 17-18, Ezekiel 44:15-16, 1 Timothy 5:8, Romans 3:23).
- Our relationship with ourselves: It is as you have a relationship with God that you discover yourself. In relating with yourself, you must know your limits, what angers you, etc. You will not be capable of loving others until you love yourself. (2 Corinthians 5:16).
- Our relationship with others: Man was not created to be alone. We are social creatures; we need others.
- Our relationship with our environment: You must take care of your environment. Leave wherever you go better than how you met it. How you relate to it determines what it yields to you.

In fact, God is light. "This then is the message which we have heard of Him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all" (1 John 1:5)

MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

THE HIGHEST FORM OF RELATIONSHIPS (PART 2)

Your relationship with God must flow from a place of love, not what you can get from Him. Our relationship with God is vertical - we must never give Him ultimatums; those are idolatry.

You are not ripe for destiny until you manage your relationships. You can't be spiritual unless you relate to people.

Here are 4 Modes of Relationships:

- **Active:** relationships based on your character, integrity, uprightness, and emotional intelligence (fruits of the Spirit). People you are directly in contact with.

- Passive: relationships based on your reputation and people's opinions. People are watching to know if you are diligent and honourable.

 Potential: relationships that will yield to you in the future. The ones you will come into.

 Destiny: relationships you need to fulfil God's purpose for and in your life. Your breakthroughs. Here, Satan fights you because he understands the importance of this level of relationship to your destiny. Only God can open your eyes to see and know who your destiny relationships are.

Consistently ask God about the role of those in your life because everything in your life or that happens to you is based on your knowledge and understanding in managing the relationships you currently have or have had. There is nobody you meet by mistake.

Manage your relationships well because everything God gives you will come through relationships. How you manage relationships, especially when they don't go right, matters a lot. Treat people well and leave relationships well. (1 Samuel 30:3-18, John 14:6, Acts 14:16-17, 17:30. Psalm 103:13-15. 1 Peter 5:8. Ephesians 2:19. Romans 8:15).

Business Permits and Licenses:
