SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY: FAITH AND MANIFESTATIONS

Any faith that leaves God to do everything is an irresponsible faith. The Bible says that faith without corresponding action is dead (James 2:17-26). Whenever we receive a prophecy or promise from God's Word, we must take steps to see the manifestation. If we do not take these steps, that prophecy or promise from God might never be fulfilled.

So, it works like this: God must show you something from His Word, which could come as a promise or a prophecy. You can't manufacture Rhema, which is God's spoken Word to you.

And how do you know God is the one speaking to you?

1. Something will come alive in your heart as you hear the Word. The Spirit of God will quicken the Word (John 6:63).
2. There will be joy in your heart (Isaiah 55:10).
3. You will experience peace.

Faith is when you don't walk according to your present circumstances but according to God's Word. Faith can come to us naturally when we do what is written concerning us (Psalm 37:4).

Just like everyone has the DNA of their parents, so it is with us in the kingdom. Faith is in our DNA, and it activates the very time we surrender our lives to Jesus. Before faith will come, there must be hope, which is a confident expectation that good will come based on our knowledge of God.

God wants us to call on Him anytime we take new steps because He had plans for our lives long before we were born (Jeremiah 1:5).

MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

THE JUST SHALL LIVE BY FAITH

Faith is the DNA of every believer; without it, we can not receive anything God has in store for us. The Bible says that the just shall live by faith, meaning faith is every believer's oxygen.

As believers, we're expected to live by faith. Faith comes by hearing and hearing the Word of God. So how can we achieve this? Deuteronomy 6:6 tells us to store up God's Word in our hearts. (Deuteronomy 11:18) By meditation. Faith doesn't work until you're fully persuaded of what God has told you. It is the Word of God that you have stored up in your heart that you begin to confess.

The Bible says about the woman with the issue of blood that she kept saying.... (Mark 5:26-28). She believed so strongly because she had heard about Jesus and kept confessing. And eventually, she got her miracle. This is exactly how believers should be.

Jesus even mentioned in Mark 9:23 that all things are possible to him who believes. Our hearts are fertile soil for the Word of God and for faith to grow. We can continuously confess the Word in Faith to see manifestations of what we desire (2 Corinthians 4:13). A faith that does not speak is not a real faith.

But we must take note of this warning: never let a problem become an emergency because faith works with patience; it takes time. So, the earlier we begin exercising faith, the better.

As we confess, calling forth those things that are not, God will start planting the heavens in our lives (Isaiah 51:16). Everything we call forth are things God has already prepared for us (Ephesians 1:3, 1 Peter 1:3-5, 8).

How do we know when we're working in faith?

1. By the words we speak.
2. By our attitude (1 Samuel 1:17-18).
3. By corresponding actions (James 2:17, 26).





Jesus declared in Mark 9:23, "Everything is possible for one who believes." This profound statement unveils the supernatural power available to every believer. Faith isn't just a religious concept—it's a spiritual force transforming impossibilities into realities.

Understanding Biblical Faith

What is Faith?

Hebrews 11:1 defines it perfectly: "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see." This divine principle operates in both spiritual and natural realms:

- It's the substance of hope.
- It's the evidence of unseen realities.
- It's the bridge between promises and fulfillment.
- It's the currency of God's kingdom.

The Universal Principle

Even unbelievers unconsciously apply this principle, demonstrating its fundamental role in human achievement. Whether in business, education, or personal goals, faith—the confident expectation of desired outcomes—drives success. However, as believers, we have access to a higher dimension of faith that connects us directly with God's unlimited power.

Building Strong Faith

The Divine Recipe

Romans 10:17 provides the clear formula: "Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God." This reveals the systematic process of faith development:

3. Practice Diligence: Motherhood requires hard work, but it's also an opportunity to cultivate diligence and perseverance.
