THE POWER OF THANKSGIVING

Thanksgiving is a powerful concept that appears in the Scripture multiple times. (Philippians 4:6). Thanksgiving is a prerequisite for breakthrough; it solidifies one's testimony. There are several examples in the Bible of people who gave thanks even in dire situations. Some of them include Daniel (Daniel 6:10-12), David (2 Samuel 6:14), the Leper whom Jesus healed (Luke 17:16) and Jesus too (John 11:41), to mention a few.

There are several reasons to thank God. They include:

It is a command (1 Thessalonians 5:18).
God loads us daily with benefits (Psalm 68:19). (Psalm 68:19). It is a good thing to praise the Lord (Psalm 92:1-2). God's plans for us are good and not evil (Jeremiah 29:11). MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

WHY STORMS COME AND **HOW TO ESCAPE THEM!**

A storm is a violent disturbance of your peace and it comes to do 3 things: to destroy, to change your direction and to bring fear.

There are 3 sources of storms:

- 1. Doing business on great waters: (Psalm 107:23-30).
- 2. God: (Psalm 107:25; 148:8).
- 3. The devil: Mark (4:37).

Every storm is stirred by the wind, and God also controls the wind. Whenever we experience storms, it is important to find out what the source of the storm is and who is stirring the wind so that we can respond accurately and adequately to them.

Now not every storm is a result of the terrain we are playing in and is from the devil. Sometimes, the storm we experience in our lives is from God. God does not just do anything without a reason for it. Same way, He doesn't send a storm without a reason.

There are several reasons why God sends storms. These include:

1. Disobedience to God (Jonah 1:1-15).

2. Evil Association (2 Chronicles 20:35-37). In Proverbs 12:26, the Bible says the righteous man should choose his friends carefully. God, being our heavenly Father, is very particular about our relationships. 3. Ignoring divine leading (Acts 27:9-26). In Acts 27, we see the consequence of ignoring divine leading. They lost not just their properties but also the ship. But for God's mercies, they would have also lost their lives. The primary way we are led as believers is by the inward witness. (Isaiah 55:12-13) shows us evidence of being led by the inward witness - we have peace and joy. Whenever we do not experience Joy and Peace in our hearts when doing anything as believers, the Lord is not leading us.
