SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY:

FAITH AND THE SUPERNATURAL

There are two realms - the physical and the spiritual realms. With the physical realm, we are able to navigate with our senses, that is, our sense of smell, touch, sight, hearing and taste. However, the spiritual realm is entirely different.

For one to operate in the physical realm, that person must be born with a physical body, but in the spiritual realm, to have a ticket to operate there, we must be born again. Anybody operating the spiritual realm without being born again is doing so illegally.

Faith is the currency with which every believer operates the spiritual realm. The Bible says that the just shall live by faith (Habakkuk 2:4, Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11, Hebrews 10:38). Without Faith, it's impossible to receive anything from the spiritual realm. The Bible describes faith as the substance of things hoped for and the evidence of things not seen (Hebrews 11:1). This clearly means that for us to receive anything from God, we must have faith.

There are three heavens (2 Corinthians 12:2-4): (1) Third Heaven - where God dwells; (2) Second Heaven - where the devil and principalities and powers are; and (3) First Heaven - where humans dwell — the physical realm.

So, when we pray, God hears us and answers these prayers; however, the answers are withheld in the second heaven, where principalities and powers are, but if we persist in prayers, we get answers. We must be ready to persevere in faith until we see the manifestation of our prayers. This is the key to operating in the spiritual.



MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

HOW TO RECEIVE REVELATIONS FROM GOD

In Deuteronomy 29:29, the Bible shows us that the secret things of God belong to those who belong to Him. It means that we can only know about God and things of God by revelation and not by merely knowing scriptures. When God gives us any revelation from His Word, it is for us to obey, to put into practice; It is not just for our knowledge

7 Reasons we need revelation from the Lord:

Saturday

- 1.So that faith will come (Romans 10:17).
 2.Because every time we receive revelation from God, we are put in charge (Matthew 16:13-19).
 3. It is how we access what God has prepared for us (1 Corinthians 2:9-10).
 4. To see and know what makes for our peace (Luke 19:41-44).
 5. For spiritual enlightenment (Ephesians 1:16-17, 2 Corinthians 4:4, Acts 26:18).
 6. Because the revelation of God is the highest form of knowledge (Jeremiah 9:23-24, Acts 4:13).
 7. Because of discernment (Acts 16:16-18, 1 Corinthians 12:1).

Acts 24

Every revelation we receive becomes a family heritage (Deuteronomy 29:29). So how do we receive revelation from God? It is through the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 2:9-10). The Holy Spirit can only dwell in someone who's born-again. Anyone operating with revelation outside of being born-again is occultic

But the thing is that it is possible to be a believer and still not have revelations. How can we ensure that we do not fall into this category? The secret is in being like a child in the sense that we can be easily persuaded by the Word of God (Matthew 11:25-26; 18:3, Luke 10:17-21). It is not in the immaturity or lack of understanding as is common with little children (1 Corinthians 14:20, Hebrews 5:13).

God does not like stubbornness at all especially when it's towards His Word. He sees it as the sin of witchcraft (1

- Four Characteristics of a Spiritual Babe:
 Babes are pure in heart. This talks about motive (Matthew 5:8, Psalm 24:1-7).
 They are meek meaning they are teachable (Matthew 5:5, Psalm 25:9,12,14, Proverbs 4:3).
 They are poor in spirit (Matthew 5:3). Being poor in spirit means you are not self-righteous (Luke 18:9-14).
 They make no reputations for themselves (Philippians 2:7). You'd never hear them say things like, "Do you know who I am?" They live to satisfy only one Person God.
