SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY:

UPON MOUNT ZION SHALL BE DELIVERANCE

Mount Zion is the New Testament Church (Obadiah 1:17): You can't begin to call forth your inheritance until deliverance has taken place in your life. The deliverance is when the light of God comes into your heart (Psalm 36:9).

WHAT THE HOLY SPIRIT DOES WHEN WE COME TO CHURCH:

- **Discovery of Purpose** (Luke 4:14-22, 2 Timothy 1:9): When you discover your purpose, grace becomes available to help you fulfil it.
- **The Church is a place of illumination** (Psalm 73:17, Psalm 18:28): Hosea 4:6 reminds us that God's people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. In the church, through the teaching of God's Word and the work of the Holy Spirit, our understanding is enlightened, and we gain clarity about truth.
- **The Church is a Place of Power** (Acts 10:38): Nobody can fulfil their purpose without being empowered by the Holy Spirit. As the Word is spoken in the church, the Spirit, who is also the anointing, enters us, empowering us to live out our purpose and make a difference in the world.
- **Presentation of ourselves before God and the Saints and the innumerable company of Angels** (Hebrews 12:22-24): As we gather, the blood of Jesus cleanses us from all sin, and we are welcomed into the presence of God and His heavenly host.
- **It is a Place of Deliverance** (Luke 13:10-17): In the church, people are set free from bondage, healed, and delivered by the power of God. Joel 2:32 promises, "And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved".

In essence, when we gather in the Church, the Holy Spirit assists us in finding our purpose, enlightens our minds, empowers us, presents us before God, and brings deliverance into our lives.

MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

MOVED BY THE WIND

In John 3:1-8, Jesus used the analogy of the wind to describe a believer. He said that no one knows where the wind is going or where it comes from. This doesn't mean that a believer is or should be erratic. Instead, it suggests that a believer should have the quality of being unpredictable. Being erratic implies not having a fixed course, but being unpredictable means that no one can limit your life because they won't know your next move.

Why did Jesus use the wind as an analogy for believers?

- **Constant Warfare:** Believers are in constant spiritual warfare (Ephesians 6:12). One aspect of warfare is being unpredictable (2 Samuel 5:17-25). God may use different strategies at different times, which is why it's essential to walk with the Holy Spirit.
- **Manifestation of God's Wisdom:** It demonstrates the manifold wisdom of God (1 Corinthians 2:6-8).
- **Faith Building:** Using the wind analogy increases our faith in Him. Our faith must be tested. (1 Corinthians 6:2-8).
- **Manifestation of God's Power:** It displays the power of God.
- **Transformation of Lives:** The blowing wind symbolizes the transformation of lives (Matthew 3:8-9). True repentance, indicated by the fruit produced, is essential for being born again (John 15:1-8).

There are deep things that God has prepared for us, and we can only understand these through the revelation of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 2:9-10). Yielding to the Spirit of God allows us to receive this revelation.
