SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY:

WHY STORMS COME AND HOW TO ESCAPE THEM — PART 2 & 3

Doing Business on Great Waters (Psalm 107:23-25):

Venturing on great waters involves stepping out of your comfort zone to pursue endeavours. Every task God assigns requires faith, which means taking steps without physical assurances. While prayer is essential, there are times when faith demands action based on God's instructions. For instance, in (Luke 5:1-7), Jesus instructed Peter to cast his net into the deep, resulting in a miraculous catch. Revelation from God's Word not only enlightens but also provides specific instructions crucial for experiencing remarkable outcomes. As believers, commitment to God and our endeavours are paramount for accomplishing exploits.

To navigate through storms, we must control our speech (James 3:2-4). Our words during storms dictate our life's course. Even ami adversity, maintaining positive confessions is vital, as (Proverbs 18:21) highlights the power of the tongue in shaping our reality. Enduring storms while walking in faith is expected, but God promises a way out (1 Corinthians 10:13). Furthermore, (James 1:2-5) encourages us to embrace patience, leading to spiritual maturity and abundance.

The Devil as a Source of Storms:Job's ordeal exemplifies facing storms instigated by the devil (Job 1:6-22). Similar to many today, he endured various trials orchestrated by the devil. Nonetheless, (Luke 10:19) affirms believers' authority over the devil and his works.

In addressing storms caused by the devil, we follow Jesus' pattern in (Mark 4:35-39) He rebuked the wind, representing spirits, before calming the sea. Behind every destructive force lies a spirit, necessitating rebuke of the underlying spiritual cause. This approach aligns with the three directions of prayer: towards God, circumstances, and created entities. (James 4:7) emphasizes submitting entirely to God to ensure the effectiveness of our words, addressing any compromises hindering our prayers' efficacy.

IN THE EYE OF THE STORM

MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

The Word of God that brings faith has within it what we need to defeat ant storm. (Romans 10:17). For the just to live by faith, they must be acquainted with the terrain of faith which includes storms. (James 1:2-3, 1 Peter 1:5-7).

If your faith is genuine, it will be tested. In the terrain of faith, storms and turbulence are normal. (1 Peter 5:9). When believing God for something, it must be based solely on the Word you hear from God

To overcome any storm, your focus must remain on Jesus. (Hebrews 12:2). Here is how to do so:

- Jesus is the Word so focus on the Word. The Word of God must be your most dominant thought, daily. Leave no room for fear. Fear and faith can't stay together. (1 Timothy 1:7, 1 Samuel 17: 4-11).
- Your focus should be on Philippians 4:8 no matter what.
- Build up yourself in the spirit by reading the Word of God and engaging in things of the spirit.
 E.g., speaking in tongues for at least 30 minutes daily. (Ephesians 6:10-17. Proverbs 6:6-8, 24:10, 18:14).

God expects us to strengthen our spirit man daily. (1 Samuel 17:38-39) and this is how to do it:

- You must be submitted to God by obeying His Word fully. (James 4:7).
- You must have regular fellowship with God and the saints as this the beauty and glory of God rub
 off on you and sharpens you. (Hebrews 10:25).
- Praying in tongues consistently. This edifies your spirit. (1 Corinthians 14:4).
- Execute and do the Word of the Lord. (Joel 2:11).
- You must have Joy rejoice always. The Joy of the Lord comes because of the illuminated Word of God in your heart. This Joy is the strength of the Lord. It is when the Word is revealed.
