SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY: THE RECEIVING FAITH

It is through faith that we receive from God. Ephesians 1:19-21 shows us though we are physically on earth, we're spiritually seated with Christ far above principalities and powers.

This covenant consciousness will help us understand and utilise our authority in Christ and recognise that everything we have is by God's grace, including our salvation. God hates it when we are self-righteous (Isaiah 64:6, Luke 18:10-14). God also hates it when we act entitled like we deserve rewards for every righteous thing we do (1 John 1:16-17, Romans 4:1-6)

There are 7 reasons why we don't receive from God. They are:
1. Distractions (2 Kings 2:9-10). These are Satan's most dangerous weapons against our receiving from God.
2. Lack of understanding of the Word of God (Matthew 13:19, Hosea 4:6, Proverbs 4:7). Understanding gives us dominion over the issues of life.

- 3. Unforgiveness (Mark 11:24-26).

 4. Unconfessed sin—Proverbs 28:13, 1 John 1:1. Admitting our faults without being defensive or blaming it on others demonstrates a meek spirit, and God loves those with a meek spirit. Receiving faith can't work where there's condemnation. Once we confess our sins and genuinely repent, God blots out our sins and does not remember them anymore (Isaiah 43:25).

 5. Doubt - James 1:5-8. Doubt is when someone is double-minded. The
- two roots of doubt are incomplete knowledge of God and Defilement
- (Titus 1:15). 6.Unbelief is when someone can't be persuaded (Matthew 11:25-27, 1 Samuel 15:23). Unbelief is an obvious indication of a hardened heart. To cure this, you must become a person who believes easily.

 7. Little Foxes (Songs of Solomon 2: 15) - A few examples are speaking

carelessly (jesting), being careless about spiritual things (eg your quiet time with God)



MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

HOW TO RELEASE THE POWER OF GOD INTO ANY SITUATION

The power of God can be released into any situation when one speaks the sent Word of God under the anointing of the Holy Spirit (Psalm 33:6, 9; 148:5).

For things to align in our lives, we must speak the 'Thus says the Lord' Word from God. (Exodus 4:1-5;17,20). The spoken Word of God always goes with His breath. The rod is the Word of God, and the breath is the staff/Spirit of God. The Word of God and the Holy Spirit go together. (Psalm 23:4; 2:5-9).

- How To Release The Power Of God In Any Situation:
 1. Tremble, fear and reverence the Word of God: (Exodus 4:3. Psalm 138:2. Proverbs 28:14 TPT). You can't treat the Word of God lightly and expect it to work for you. Magnify the Word of God.
 - 2. Take the Word of God and have the courage to believe and obey it by faith, even if others won't.
 - 3. Proclaim the Word of God in faith declare it. Say it with your mouth. (Exodus 14:14-16).

3 Ways To Proclaim God's Word:

- Confession: this is in 3 parts (i) Confess Jesus as Lord (Romans 10:9-10). (ii) Confess your sins (1 John 1:8-9). (iii) Confessing Scriptures — saying the same thing as God (Hebrews 3:1).
- Prophesy the Word of God: This is a specific Word that God has given you for yourself and others.
- Proclamation: This is to boldly and publicly proclaim the Word of God regardless of public opinion or backlash. We are to enforce and proclaim the judgement written. (Psalm 149:5-9). If you are prone to thinking negatively, you can use God's Word to change your thoughts.

1. Daily Prayer Habits

"Pray continually" (1 Thessalonians 5:17)
- Start the day with shared prayer

- Pray before meals
- End the day in prayer together
- Create prayer routines that work for both

2. Specific Prayer Support

"Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed" (James

- Share specific prayer requests
- Follow up on previous prayers
- Keep a prayer journal together Celebrate answered prayers

3. Crisis Prayer Support

"Cast your cares on the LORD, and he will sustain you" (Psalm 55:22)

- Stop and pray immediately when issues arise
- Stand together in faith during challenges

- Remind each other of God's promises
- Seek spiritual counsel when needed

Building Strong Prayer Support

1. Create a Safe Space

"Love always protects, always trusts, always perseveres" always hopes, Corinthians 13:7)

- Foster emotional safety
- Maintain confidentiality
- Show empathy and understanding
- Listen without judgment

2. Develop Prayer Skills

"In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans" (Romans 8:26)

- Learn to pray scripture Study prayer together
- Attend prayer workshops Share prayer insights

3. Maintain Consistency

"They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer" (Acts 2:42)

- Set regular prayer times
- Keep commitments to pray together
- Be flexible when needed
- Don't let busyness interrupt prayer time
