Sunday Summary:

LET THE REDEEMED OF THE LORD SAY SO

When God created man, He elevated him to a significant position. However, when man sinned, he fell from this lofty place and surrendered his authority to Satan. Despite Adam's initial transgression, all of us, being his descendants, inherited this sinful nature. Hence, God undertook the task of redeeming mankind from the bondage of sin, which culminated in the redemption through the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ.

The system of redemption was established among the Israelites during Moses' time, as detailed in Leviticus 25:47-49. Hebrews 2:14-15 highlights the immense price Jesus paid for our redemption. Therefore, it is crucial for us, the redeemed, to vocalize and uphold what we have received, lest we risk losing its

In Mark 11:22, Jesus taught the power of faith in God and the significance of speaking without doubt. Psalm 107:3 emphasizes the importance of verbal affirmation. As believers, it is incumbent upon us to consistently proclaim the Word of God wherever we go, as silence toward any issue leads to its demise.

There are four compelling reasons why we must continually speak the Word of God: First, God created man as a speaking spirit (Genesis 2:7). Second, God has ordained us as kings, empowering us to enforce change through speech (Ecclesiastes 8:4). Third, the tongue holds the power of life and death (Proverbs 18:21). Lastly, our words justify our actions (Matthew 12:37).

However, speaking with doubt diminishes effectiveness. True belief originates in the spirit, founded on personal revelations from God. Signs of God's communication include righteousness, peace, and joy in our hearts (Psalm 85:8; Psalm 12:3). Once peace and joy are established, we can confidently

In conclusion, let us remember that our words hold immense power, and by speaking in alignment with God's truth, we enact positive changes in our lives and surroundings (Romans 10:10).




