Sunday Service Summary: Taking Supernatural Leaps February 11, 2024

The Bible recounts Jesus expelling money lenders from the temple, declaring it a place of prayer, not theft. Following this, the blind and lame sought healing from Him.

This story holds implications for us today, suggesting that spiritual blindness and lameness hinder supernatural progress. There are three essential levels of perception: Seeing to understand, Seeing to possess, and seeing into the spirit realm.

Abraham exemplifies perceiving to possess, walking the land he was promised. Similarly, Elisha's servant gained spiritual sight to perceive angelic protection. Jesus also healed the lame, symbolizing the need to act upon spiritual insight. Just as God instructed Abraham and Joshua to physically possess their promised lands, spiritual insight demands active engagement.

Four categories of people require supernatural intervention: those with inherent limitations, those facing insurmountable challenges, those in peril or danger, and those pressed for time.

One effective method to achieve this supernatural advancement is through prayer. Therefore, if you seek insight into God's guidance concerning yourself or your circumstances, or if you require healing for any spiritual stagnation, you may be encountering, allocate time to commune with God in prayer today and throughout the week.

It is not what you know but what you do with what you know that makes all the difference. Knowledge, alone by itself, will only puff you up. (1 Corinthians 8:1). Just like a balloon, anything puffed up will burst at the faintest contact with a pin. You don't want your life to be like that.

The Word of God explicitly stated that knowledge, not wisdom, will increase in the last days. (Daniel 12:4). But an increase in knowledge does not automatically translate to an increase in wisdom. This is because there is a huge difference between knowledge and wisdom.



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Mid-Week Sermon Summary IN LEAPS AND IN BOUNDS

2 Peter 1:8-9

Whenever God does something, He wants it to get better and better. Proverbs 4:18. What differentiates the righteous from the wicked is the light of God. Proverbs 4:19. John 9:1-7. Blind people are unable to live which is why God wants us to see clearly to experience divine leaps. Isaiah 59:10. When we don't see, we Stumble, Fall, get Broken, become Snared and finally, get Taken.

4 Principles for Divine Speed:

 See Clearly: stumbling causes your faith to waver so you can't receive anything from God. James 1:5-8.

2) Seeing Far: regardless of your situation or circumstance, you can still look up and see far. It is what you see that God confirms. Proverbs 22:3, 27:12. 2 Kings 6:17.

3) Forgetfulness: this leads to ingratitude. James 1:22-25. Deuteronomy 8:16-18. The Word of God is in 2 parts – HEARING and DOING. You can only do the Word of God you remember. Psalm 9:17.

4) Particular Paths to Walk: the only path that leads to Spiritual Leaps is HOLINESS – it is an expressway without holdups or traffic. Hebrews 12:12-13. Isaiah 35:8. Matthew 7:13-14.
