SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY:

HE IS RISEN!

The passing of our Lord Jesus has unlocked a multitude of benefits for us. His demise and subsequent resurrection illustrate two significant truths:

1. God's Wisdom (1 Corinthians 1:25, Colossians 2:14 - 15): At times, God's plans may seem foolish to human understanding. Scripture emphasizes that divine wisdom surpasses human intellect. The devil influenced Judas, the religious leaders, and many others to crucify Jesus, believing it would thwart His mission. However, unbeknownst to him, this action perfectly aligned with God's plan to atone for our sins, offering salvation to all.

Similarly, in our lives, we may encounter circumstances that appear perplexing, yet Jesus' death and resurrection remind us of God's sovereignty. Even when His instructions seem unconventional, we must trust in His omniscience and supreme authority.

2. The Resurrection Power (Romans 8:11-15):

God raised Jesus from the dead on the third day after His crucifixion, showcasing His ability to resurrect the dead. One of the fundamental aspects of being a true disciple of Christ is dying to oneself. Without this spiritual death, we cannot experience the transformative power of God's resurrection. Sometimes, our prayers for deliverance may not align with God's plan. Similar to Jesus' ordeal, God may lead us through trials to demonstrate His resurrection power. Consider if God had spared Jesus from crucifixion at the hands of religious leaders and others—salvation would not have been possible.

Therefore, how do we allow ourselves to die? It is by fully and wholeheartedly surrendering to God's will, just as Jesus did. Only then can we encounter His resurrection power.

MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

ENGAGING THE LAW OF RESURRECTION FOR A CHANGE OF LEVEL

As Jesus's impending departure drew near, a significant event occurred. Despite His ministry primarily focusing on the Jewish community, some Greeks sought an audience with Him. However, Jesus responded by declaring that the time had come for the Son of Man to be glorified (John 12:20-25). He then imparted a profound statement that unveils the principle of resurrection: "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain." (John 12:24).

In this context, death symbolizes surrendering our will, passions, desires, and aspirations to God—yielding complete control of our lives to Him. Jesus epitomized this surrender, living solely to fulfil God's will. Resurrection necessitates death. Throughout the Bible, numerous individuals underwent experiences akin to death yet emerged as prominent figures whom God used mightily in their time. Examples include Jacob, Joseph, Moses, and Ruth, among others. Despite facing perplexing circumstances, they surrendered to God's will and were ultimately glorified by Him.

Let us remember that the scriptures serve as lessons for our lives. Through the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we can emulate Jesus's example by surrendering entirely to God. It's crucial to recognize that resurrection is unattainable without death
