SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY: THE CALLING OF MOTHERHOOD MOTHERS' DAY SPECIAL

God made man in His image, and He made us male and female (Genesis 1:26-27, Matthew 19:4). Anything contrary to this is Satan's attempt to corrupt the image of God.

A mother was first made female because she was made with a womb to carry seed. A woman can be a mother by being married and having a child, by adopting or assuming the responsibility of a mother for another person's child. Motherhood is a calling from God.

5 Purposes of Motherhood:

- It is redemptive (Luke 1:5-45; 8:2-3; Revelation 12:1-4).
- It is a model of God's authority structure in the home.
- Mothers are builders (Proverbs 14:1).
- Mothers are gatherers (Luke 13:34-36).
- Mothers are God's reproductive agents on the earth.

There are four stages of motherhood:

- A mother is to be a nurturer. (Acts 7:23). Job 39:14-16).
- A mother is a refiner.
- A mother is to be an example. (Proverbs 31:10-31).
- A mother is to be a witness. A woman who wants to be a successful mother must draw near to the Lord.

A mother has the sole responsibility of raising her children (Proverbs 22:6; 29:15).

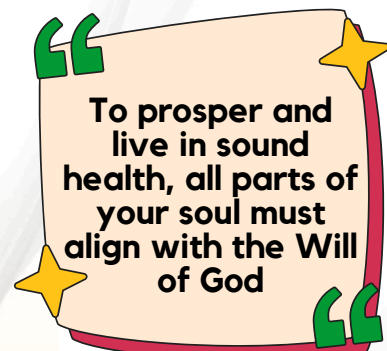
I want to glorify and thank God for remembering me after so many years of being childless.

Daily Devotional

David was disappointed when his benefactor, Achish, requested that he not go with them to the battle against Israel. Over the years, as Saul pursued him to kill him, David fled from the land of Israel and made close acquaintance with Achish, a Philistine lord with whom he sought refuge.

At one point, the Philistine lords went out to fight King Saul and all of Israel, and Achish being summoned, took David and his men with him. But the lords of the Philistines rejected David and his men. (1 Samuel 29:1-7).

That rejection was a big blessing in disguise in many ways for David. This is because King Saul and his three sons, Jonathan, Abinadab, and Malchishua, died in that battle. Had David participated, he would have been guilty of partaking in the bloodshed of the LORD's anointed, King Saul.

This same test he had passed twice earlier when he had opportunities to kill Saul but refrained. Additionally, David would have broken his covenant with Jonathan. The refusal of the Philistine lords was divinely orchestrated. It saved David's destiny.

Some disappointments and rejections are permitted by God for your good. Trust God. If He permits it, it is for your good.

MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

Soul Prosperity (Spirit, Soul and Body)

God wants us to prosper and be in health. It is His will (3 John 2). But for us to prosper and be in health, our souls must prosper.

In Genesis 1:26-27, God made man in three parts like His image—spirit (the real you), Soul (which gives you your personality), and Body (through which you can live on earth) (1 Thessalonians 5:23).

It is through our spirits that God communicates with us, but our souls serve as middlemen between the Spirit and the body.

So, what then is the soul, and how can we make it prosper?

Five things make up the soul:

- The mind: This is the reasoning part of the soul
- The will: This is the decision part of the soul
- Your emotion: This is the feeling part of the soul (James 1:20)
- Your conscience: This is the moral part of the soul (1 Timothy 1:19)
- Your memory or consciousness: This is the imaginative or memory bank of the soul (2 Corinthians 10:2-5).

The soul only prospers when it is subjected to the Word, that is, doing everything the Word instructs and commands. It is when we subject all the five components of our soul to God's Word that our souls will prosper. And in turn, our bodies will prosper (James 1:21, 1 Peter 1:9).
