






MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY: RECEIVING DOUBLE IN PRAYER!!

James 5:12-15 — prayer must be based solely on the Word of God for it to be effective. The Word of God, which is the Seed (Luke 8:11), is perfect. What determines if this seed of the Word of God will produce are (1) the state of your heart and (2) how you nurture the Word in your heart.

7 Ways to Receive Double in Prayer:

- When a thief is caught (Exodus 22:70): When you read and revel in the Word of God, then revelation concerning aspects of your life the enemy has stolen is released so you can use this revelation to pray for double restoration. (Luke 15:8-12, Jeremiah 1:11-12, Revelation 13:14-15).
- Understanding the rights of the first son (Deuteronomy 21:17): If you are in Christ, you are one with him and also a joint heir. Pray with this mindset and understanding. (Exodus 11: 1-3, John 4:34).
- When you have godly desires, especially spiritual gifts (1 Kings 2:9-12, 1 Corinthians 12:1 and 13): You need spiritual gifts to guide all your affairs.
- When you pray for others (friends, pastor, church. Etc.).
- When we go through a season of trials and do not compromise.
- When we keep confessing God's Word in faith.
- When God's servant blesses and prays for us.





Psalm 116:17

TRUST

"Her husband can trust her..." (Proverbs 31:11). The key word in the scripture is 'trust.'

You would agree that trust is lacking these days because people are not trustworthy. Unfortunately, many marriages also lack trust, which is vital for sustaining any relationship.

But why are we speaking about this for singles since the scripture referred to a married woman? The answer is in last week's article: I. It is how you are as a single person you'll be when you marry. You do not form good character overnight; it takes time. 2. A woman becomes a wife before she gets married. And this is scriptural (Proverbs 18:22).

The same goes for men. You need to develop the character of being trustworthy to effectively carry out your duties as the head of the home. Women, especially good ones, want to be married to men they can trust. No one wants an untrustworthy person to lead them; no one at all.

So, how can we become trustworthy people?

Start by always speaking the truth. If you claim that God is your Father, you should be like Him. The Bible says that God does not lie (Titus 1:2). On the contrary, it is the devil who lies and is the father of all liars (John 8:44).

Why would you be in Ikota and, on a call, tell someone you're in Ajah? "But they're close locations; they're quite close to each other," you argue. The fact is, they might be close, but they're different locations; you lied!

In God, just the way there's no partial obedience, there's no such thing as a partial truth, half-truth or white lie. Speak the truth in the little things, in the seemingly insignificant matters. Speak the truth even when casually hanging out with friends. Let's practice being truthful in all our conversations, and we'll be on the highway of being trustworthy; people others can trust.
