Many underestimate the power of focus to their peril. The condition upon which Elijah gave Elisha to receive what he asked for, which was the double portion of the anointing operating in his life, was to be focused.

"And so it was when they had crossed over, that Elijah said to Elisha, Ask! What may I do for you, before I am taken from you? Elisha said, Please let a double portion of your spirit be upon me. So he said, you asked a hard thing. Nevertheless, if you see me when I am taken from you, it shall be so for you; if not, it shall not be so" (2 Kings 2:9-10).

Elijah did not lay hands on Elisha so the latter could receive the double portion of his anointing. Elisha only had to be focused.

MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

PORTRAIT OF THE NEW TESTAMENT PRIESTHOOD

In the Old Testament, only those who were born in the lineage of Aaron, the brother of Moses could become high priests. But there were several conditions even for those born in his lineage. Not everyone could become high priests except if they met those conditions even though they were from his lineage. The Old Testament is a forecast of the New. What this means is that what was done in the past is symbolic of what is being done now. First of all, all believers have the privilege of being priests unto God whether male or female (Revelation 1:5-6, Galatians 3:26-27).

There are 3 categories of priesthood in the New Testament: 1. That which is for all believers (Revelation 1:5-6). 2. That which is for those who are called (Ephesians 4:11-12). 3. The High Priestly Ministry of our Lord Jesus.

The priesthood is very important for 3 reasons: 1. God expects that anyone who must function as a priest must not lack knowledge of Him (Hosea 4:6-7, Proverbs 28:9). 2. The priesthood is important so that our prayers will not be rejected by God (Hosea 4:7). 3. The priesthood is important because you're the one to stand in the gap for people before God (Numbers 16:41-48, 2 Chronicles 7:14).

When we want to relate with God, 3 things are very vital that we must take note of: (1) The altar which is the place of meeting between divinity and humanity; (2) The priest who is the supervisor of the altar; and (3) The temple. In the Old Testament days, the temple was a physical building but now, the temple is us, we believers (1 Corinthians 6:19, 1 Peter 2:5). Those conditions that were set by God in the Old Testament for those who'll be priests in the Aaronic order are symbolic of certain spiritual conditions that must not be in our lives if we must function as priests (Leviticus 21:16-25).

There were 12 conditions or physical impairments that God specifically mentioned that anyone who has them cannot serve as priests unto Him. They are: 1.Blindness symbolizing spiritual blindness. 2. Lameness symbolizing one who isn't fervent; one who isn't zealous for God or spiritual things. 3. Flat nose. This is symbolic of someone who can't perceive things in the spirit or one who isn't spiritually discerning. 4. Unequal legs. This symbolizes one who's lukewarm. (Luke 17:32). 5. A broken arm which symbolizing on unfaithful person. 6. A broken arm which symbolizes one who is unable to bear the burdens of Christ 7. A hunchback symbolizing one who's filled with anxiety and the cares of this life. 8. A dwarf. This symbolizes one whose spiritual growth is stunted. 9. A spot in the eyes. This is symbolic of someone who has unforgiveness in his/her heart. 10. A festering eruption. This is symbolic of one who das an addiction. 12. A crushed testicle. This symbolizes one who doesn't bear fruit.

A King and A Priest...

It feels very good when you have authority. It's great to be able to give commands and see them carried out. As Christians, we are called 'A royal priesthood...' (1 Peter 2:9).

But notice the scripture doesn't stop at 'royal.' There's also priesthood. This means that we are to be both kings and priests. Why is being a priest so important? Because it determines how effective our 'kingship' will be.

As kings, we command authority but as priests, we commune with God. If our communication system with God is defective, we won't be able to command any authority. What this means is that, while serving as priests unto God, we can gain classified information about various aspects of our lives - one of which is who to marry.
