Sunday Summary: The Power of Righteousness March 03, 2024

Righteousness can be understood simply as doing what is right. However, there's a distinction between what is deemed right in human eyes and what aligns with God's standards. Hence, righteousness involves believing in God's Word and obeying His commands.

The devil, being aware of the glorious future God has ordained for us, attempts to lure us into compromise.

What, then, are the benefits of righteousness?

1. It delivers from death (Proverbs 10:2, 11:4)
2. It delivers from destruction (Genesis 19:1-19)
3. It directs your way (Proverbs 11:5, Psalms 23:1-3)

Apart from the benefits, righteousness does several things in our lives.

These include:

1. It exalts (Proverbs 14:34)
2. It makes you bold (the kind that is of the Spirit) (Proverbs 28:1)
3. It increases the anointing (Psalm 45:7)

Living righteously automatically attracts God's favour. So, don't compromise. Even if no one sees you, God does and remember that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.

After the multitude was organized, the Lord Jesus prayed. He blessed and broke the five barley loaves and two fishes before He gave them out. (Mark 6:41). There is an important point here: whatever or whoever God blesses, He will also break.

Until you are broken, you will not be used by God to be a blessing to others. Many are not manifesting the blessing of God because they are yet to be broken by God. God does not use who or what He has not broken.

Man can use or employ the blessed but unbroken, but never God. Abraham, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, David, Peter, and Paul were all broken before God used them.

This brokenness is all about the breaking of the carnal nature of man so that the life of the Spirit can be released for 'it is the Spirit that gives life. The carnal nature of man profits nothing' (John 6:63).

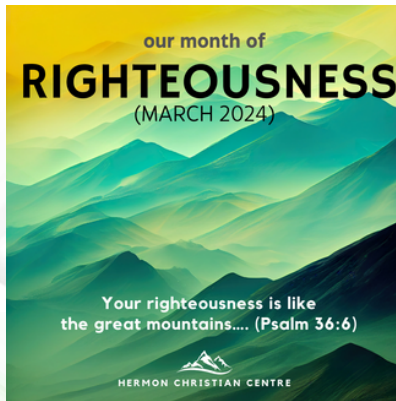

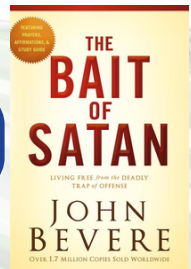

Mid-Week Sermon

THE KINGDOM MEAL – HOLY COMMUNION SERVICE

When we experience spiritual rebirth, we are transitioned from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of God (Colossians 1:13). In God's realm, there is a singular meal, distinct from our natural sustenance, with its unique ingredients. In Romans 14:17, Scripture outlines these ingredients as righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit.

Just as each component of a meal provides specific nutrients to the body, so does each ingredient of the kingdom meal. Righteousness, signifying a correct standing with God, generates a longing within us to prioritize His will over our desires. Jesus exemplified this in John 4:34, expressing His commitment to fulfilling God's will. Failing to seek God's will leads to emptiness, discontentment, and dissatisfaction, as seen in the life of Solomon.

Peace is the natural outcome of righteousness (Isaiah 32:17). Living rightly eradicates fear and fosters prosperity, as miracles flourish where peace abounds. Abraham's avoidance of strife with Lot (Genesis 13:8) underscores this principle, as the Holy Spirit avoids strife-ridden environments.

Joy serves as a source of strength (Nehemiah 8:10), enabling breakthroughs and miraculous experiences. Isaiah 12:3 emphasizes that joy facilitates drawing from the wells of salvation, unlocking new dimensions in our lives. Paul and Silas' praise amid adversity (Acts 16:22-24) illustrates the potency of joy, which transcends outward circumstances. Certain chapters of our lives remain dormant until activated by joy.
