SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY: PRAISE GETS THE JOB DONE - PART 1

Have you ever found yourself praying and fasting fervently for something, only to feel nothing is happening? In such moments, consider shifting your focus to praise; it can work wonders. While we may sometimes pray amiss, we can never truly praise amiss.

The Protocol of Praise

God delights in our praise, but there is a divine protocol we must follow to ensure our praise is effective. This protocol is beautifully illustrated in Psalm 100:1-5. When approaching God with praise, we should begin with thanksgiving and then ascend into praise. This sequence sets the stage for a deeper connection with the Divine.

The Mystery of Praise

Understanding the mystery of praise opens the door to unmerited favour and prevents us from labouring in vain. What might take others ten years to achieve can be accomplished in a much shorter time through the power of praise. However, to enter our promised land, we must first confront obstacles—like the River Jordan—and seek God's strategies for overcoming them. One of the most powerful strategies He provides is the strategy of praise.

Principles of Establishment

The three foundational principles of establishment are Knowledge, Understanding, and Wisdom:

- Knowledge: This refers to a body of related and relevant information about a particular field.
- Understanding: This is knowing how that knowledge works and how to apply it.
- Wisdom: This involves adapting knowledge and understanding to our specific situations.

The holy Scriptures recorded that the Lord Jesus Christ wept twice. The first time was at the tomb of Lazarus. (John 11:35).

The second time, He beheld the city of Jerusalem and wept over it because they did not recognise their time of visitation. (Luke 19:41-44).

When you do not recognise your time of visitation (also known as the set time or, in the Greek language, 'Kairos'), you will definitely miss it. This is one of the reasons that the Lord Jesus often warned us to 'watch and pray.'

If you miss the set time of your visitation, you forfeit the window of divine opportunity for the supernatural performance of God's promises in your life.

So, we are to pray all prayers in the Spirit and watch in the Spirit with all perseverance (Ephesians 6:18).

MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

PRAISE GETS THE JOB DONE – PART 2

Anyone who wants to enter the promised land must pass through River Jordan and Jericho. The strategy to pass through must come from God, which is Praise. (Ecclesiastes 10 vs 10 & 15).

You need wisdom, knowledge and understanding to build anything. (Proverbs 24 vs 3). There's no trade without secrets. Seek wisdom, knowledge and understanding before you embark on anything.

Don't praise any king higher than you praise God. Praise God with understanding. Your understanding makes your praise weighty in the spirit and converts your praise to answers.

(Psalm 47 vs 6): Praises are sung. If it is not an utterance from your mouth, it is not praise. Sing praises to God as a King. Try devoting the 1st minutes of your day to God in praise. Don't praise any king higher than you praise God. Praise God with understanding

1. We build a throne for God. (Psalm 22 vs 3): The throne God sits on is the praises of his people. Anywhere God sees praise, he will come and sit there. When you're in any situation, build God a throne. There are things that will never happen where God is praised.

2. Praise gives you strength and silences the enemy at the gates. (Psalm 8 vs 2): (Matthew 21 vs 12-16). The more you praise God, the stronger you will be. Not praising God is a sign that you are weak, and when you are weak, you will become prey.

3. Praise reveals the secret things of GOD to you. (Deuteronomy 29 vs 29): (Matthew 11 vs 25). Praise opens up the seals to your destiny. God will show you the things written concerning you when you praise Him. Nothing opens the scrolls of your destiny like genuine praise to God.

4. Praise provokes harvest. (Psalm 67 vs 5-6): The increase from the earth is gotten through people praising God. If you need an increase from God, praise Him. Anytime you stop praising God, you are inviting drought and famine. When you praise God the earth of any situation will yield its increase to you.

5. Praise is the garment of your spirit man. (Psalm 61 vs 3): Once praise is taken from you, you become naked, and when you are naked, the spirit of heaviness, of depression will come upon you. Every time you are depressed, start praising God - put on the garment of praise.

Project-Specific Accounts

- Separate accounts for major projects or departments
- **Useful for:**
 - * Government contracts
 - * Large client projects
 - * Specific business divisions
 - * Grant management

Setting Up Your Business Bank Account

Required Documentation

1. Business Registration Certificate
2. Tax Identification Numbers
3. Business License
4. Proof of Business Address
5. Personal Identification
6. Partnership Agreement or Corporate Documents (if applicable)
7. Initial Deposit Funds

Steps to Open Accounts

1. **Research and Compare Banks**
 - Compare fee structures
 - Evaluate available services
 - Check minimum balance requirements
 - Review online banking capabilities
 - Assess branch and ATM locations
2. **Schedule Bank Appointment**
 - Prepare all required documents
 - Bring all business partners if required
 - Allow time for thorough discussion
3. **Complete Account Setup**
 - Sign necessary agreements
 - Set up online banking
 - Order checks and debit cards
 - Establish account signatories

4. Control Anger

"My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry" (James 1:19). Through prayer, couples learn to:

- Manage emotional reactions
- Create space for cooling down
- Think before speaking
- Respond rather than react

Practical Steps for Praying Through Conflicts

Begin with Gratitude "Give thanks in all circumstances" (1 Thessalonians 5:18)

- Start by thanking God for your spouse
- Acknowledge the good in your relationship
- Express appreciation for each other

Confess Personal Faults "Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other" (James 5:16)

- Admit your own mistakes
- Take responsibility for your actions
- Ask for forgiveness from God and spouse

Pray for Understanding "Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak" (James 1:19)

- Ask God to help you understand your spouse's perspective
- Pray for clarity in communication
- Seek wisdom in finding solutions

Seek Unity "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace" (Ephesians 4:3)

- Pray for restored harmony
- Ask for help in finding common ground
- Focus on your shared commitment to Christ
