## SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY:

### HOW TO FLOURISH AS A CHRISTIAN

One major characteristic of a cosmopolitan city is its proximity to a river or other major waterbody. A classic example is the city of Lagos. Whenever water is introduced to dry ground, things start to sprout out of it; in other words, life begins to grow out of it.

Jesus said in John 7:38 that whoever believes in Him, from his belly shall flow rivers of living water. The Bible depicts this living water as the Holy Spirit. This means that whatever change you want to see in your life as a believer must start first from within, with the help of the Holy Spirit.

What does the presence of the river (the Holy Spirit) do in our lives as Christians? We see this in Isaiah 58:11:

- He guides us.
- He satisfies our souls in drought/famine. But this is if you listen to His instructions (Genesis 26:1-6,12-14).
- He gives good health.

One of the major places where the river flows is in the house of God, our local assembly. That's why it's important that we attend services. The Holy Spirit moves, and with His move comes life and other blessings.

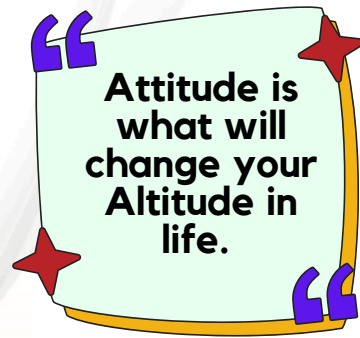

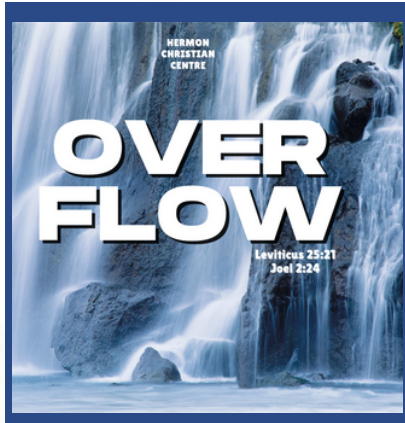

## MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

### WHERE THE RIVERS FLOW (1)

The Christian life is an 'Inside Out' life – meaning that whatever will happen to us must first be done on the inside before it manifests on the outside. (3 John 1:2).

According to John 7:38, Jesus said that rivers of living water would flow out of the bellies of everyone who believed in Him. The following verse (verse 39) further explains that He meant the Holy Spirit. Ezekiel 47: 1-10 and verse 12 depict what happens when the river flows anywhere: life is created. Things become fruitful and prosperous. Remember, this river represents the Holy Spirit.

So, it is with us. When we allow the Holy Spirit to lead us, our lives become fruitful; life is birthed in us. We become so fruitful and prosperous that it's evident in all we do.

How can we allow the Spirit of God to lead us? Romans 8:4 - 9 shows how the sinful nature is hostile towards God and refuses to obey God. This gives us an indication that to be led by the Holy Spirit, we must follow all that we're commanded in the Word of God. A lot of things go wrong in us as believers because of carnality—not subjecting ourselves to the Word of God.

**There are three types of men on earth: -**

- (1) The Natural Man: (1 Corinthians 2:14. John 3:3-5).
- (2) The Carnal Man: (Romans 8:1-8. Ezekiel 47:11. 1 Corinthians 3:1-3. Hebrews 11:6).
- (3) The Spiritual Man: Romans 8:14. 1 Corinthians 2:15).

**Characteristics of a Carnal Man: - We see these in 1 Corinthians 3: 1-3:-**

1. Immaturity (Galatians 4:1-3).
2. Selfishness. A carnal person cares only for himself or herself. They want blessings without responsibility.
3. Envy (Genesis 29:30, 30:1): Envy belittles and brings you barrenness.



**Love is not enough to sustain marriage - True or False?**

It's a popular saying that love is not enough to sustain marriage. But this saying stems from a very misconstrued understanding of Love.

Love is one of those concepts that can't be easily defined yet is seen and felt. Unfortunately, it has been reduced to mere feelings because it's not very easily defined.

**Guide to Registering a Business in Nigeria! (Part 1)**

*"Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might, for there is no work, device, knowledge, or wisdom in the grave where you are going." (Ecclesiastes 9:10 NKJV).*

As we strive to be good stewards of our talents and resources, many of us may consider starting a business. Registering your business legitimately is crucial for long-term success and aligning with legal requirements and our Christian values.

*"Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God. Therefore, whoever resists the authorities resists what God has appointed, and those who resist will incur judgment" (Romans 13:1-2 ESV).*

In Nigeria, the Companies and Allied Matters Act (CAMA) stipulates that businesses must be registered within 28 days of commencing operations. Failure to comply with this regulation not only results in a default fee of NGN150 per day until the business is registered, but it also disrupts the smooth operation of your business. This underscores the critical importance of timely registration. The Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) is Nigeria's governing body that is responsible for business registration.

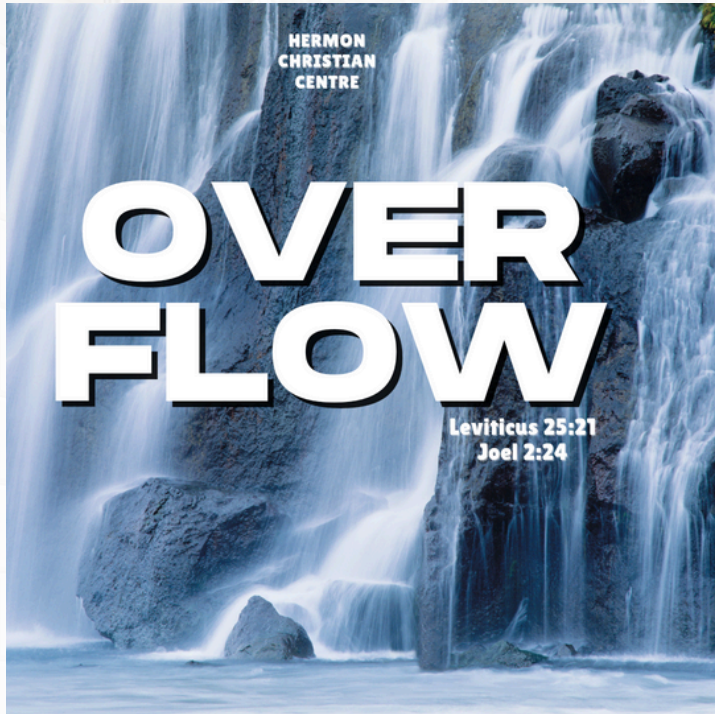
**Types of Business Registrations in Nigeria:**

Several business registrations are available in Nigeria, each with its unique structure and benefits. These include:

1. The Business Name registration type, available exclusively to Nigerians, offers a flexible structure. It's also known as sole proprietorship, enterprise, or venture. This form of registration allows for any business activity. However, in certain cases, the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) may suggest that a specific business activity be registered as a private limited company. This flexibility empowers you to select the structure that aligns best with your business needs, making it a popular choice for many entrepreneurs in Nigeria.
2. Company Limited by Shares—Under this form of registration, the shareholders are limited by the number of shares they subscribe to in the company, which can be private or publicly owned.
