Dearly Beloved,


Happy new week and a new month!

SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY: ABOVE ONLY (PART 1)

God's intention for us as believers is to rise above a life of scarcity, dependence, and vulnerability to exploitation, as highlighted in Deuteronomy 23:13. He promises that we will be the head and not the tail; those who are heads have influence and cannot be overlooked. Consequently, being positioned as the head means we will be "above only."

As children of God, we must allow Him to elevate us to this position of leadership. We are His workmanship, and with this identity comes the responsibility to maintain our elevated status. Ephesians 2:4-6 reminds us that God saved us from spiritual death by His grace—an act in which we played no part, similar to how the Israelites were delivered from Egyptian bondage (Exodus 19:4).

Through this experience of salvation, God has lifted us above our circumstances, yet we must remain vigilant, as Satan seeks to bring down genuinely born-again Christians.

To ensure we remain in this elevated position, consider the following principles drawn from Genesis 13:1-18:

- 1. Avoid Strife: Steer clear of conflict and quarrels by living above such distractions.
- 2. Elevate Your Environment: Strive to rise above the spiritual climate of your immediate surroundings.
- 3. Recognize God as Your Source: Understand that while people may serve as channels for blessings, God is your ultimate source. Cultivate a relationship with Him based on the knowledge that you are in a covenant with Him (Genesis 14:17-18, 21).

By embracing these principles, we can confidently maintain our position "above only" in our spiritual journey.



ABOVE ONLY (PART 2)

It is the teaching of God's Word that builds and gives you an inheritance. God is not irresponsible such that He will you an inheritance when He has not built you up to maturity.

To be the head is a function, not a position. All the blessings of Abraham in Genesis 28:1-13 are hinged and dependent on one thing, only — hearkening diligently to the voice of God's Word. As you diligently hearken to observe to do all that God says, He will lift you and bless all that you do.

There is a process to making you the head and not the tail. 'It shall come to pass' means a process. 'Hearken' means to listen with respectful attention.

To be the Head, heed the following:

- You must understand the covenant and demand it works in your life.
- Borrowing is a sign of poverty to borrow, ensure it is for leverage and not to eat.
- Everything that God will use to deliver you is with you now.
- · God will stop only where you stop.
- Ensure you are valuable. An asset. A blessing. Make a difference.
- Be so important that you can't be ignored.

If you want the Blessings of Abraham, you must hearken diligently to the voice of God's Word and observe to do exactly what He tells you. Faith comes by hearing God's Word — when you act on God's Word you've heard, you will be exalted. (Psalm 40:6. Romans 10:17. Isaiah 30:19-21. 2 Corinthians 4:13).

FAQs About Business Registration in Nigeria (2)

Here are some more frequently asked questions about business registration in Nigeria.

Can I register an NGO as a business in Nigeria?

NGOs are not businesses and are registered under a different category known as Incorporated Trustees.

Are annual returns mandatory for all registered businesses? Yes, every registered business entity must file annual returns with the CAC.

What are the consequences of not registering a business?

Operating an unregistered business can result in fines and legal action. It can also prevent access to banking services and the entry into enforceable contracts.

Can I register a branch of a foreign company?

Foreign companies may establish a branch or subsidiary but must adhere to specific CAC regulations.

Do I need a lawyer to register my business?

While not mandatory, legal assistance is advised to navigate the registration process effectively.
