# SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY:

# THE COMMUNICATION SYSTEM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The Bible tells us how leaders were selected to help Moses (Numbers 11: 24 - 29). The day the Spirit of God was poured on them, two selected leaders weren't present in the assembly; however, the Spirit of God still rested on them.

As believers in these last days, the Holy Spirit doesn't come upon us but resides in us when we surrender our lives to Jesus. According to Joel 2:28 and Acts 2:17, when the Holy Spirit comes into you, three things must happen. First, we prophesy, then we see visions, and then we dream dreams.

The Holy Spirit is rendered powerless if we don't speak. Words are for us to first create and then exercise dominion. Anything we don't have in our lives, we can create, and anything we don't want in our lives, we can uproot (Hebrews 11:3, Jeremiah 1:9-10).

Creating involves six steps, as seen in Jeremiah 1:9. Four involve uprooting and destroying things we don't want in our lives, and two involve planting and decreeing what we want. On the other hand, exercising dominion can be seen in Ecclesiastes 8:4.

Thus, we must be careful what we say and how we say it as Christians. We can't speak vain words and expect our words to carry power when we spea Word of God. We must also be people who keep their promises (Psalm 15:4).

We prophecy based on divine inspiration and divine revelation. This means that the more we read the Word of God and the more we listen to sermons, the more

1. It takes us to the high place (1 Samuel 10:13).
2. Prophesying activates the power of the Holy Spirit (Zechariah 4:6).
3. Prophesying destroys natural limitations (2 Kings 6).

## **MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:**

### FREEDOM BY THE SPIRIT

There is a freedom that Christ has called us into (Galatians 5:1. 2 Peter 2:19). We become slaves to whatever or whoever overcomes us, be it sin, disease, bitterness, unforgiveness, etc. Whatever hinders us from serving God or living in the fullness of what He has done for us in Christ will lead us into bondage. 2 Corinthians 3:17 tells us we should have liberty from captivity because the Holy Spirit lives inside us. Proverbs 11:9 says deliverance will come only through 'knowledge and spiritual discernment' (Mark 16:17, Luke 11:20, James 4:7).

God has given us the authority to resist the devil and bind unclean spirits and demons, but we can't bind or cast out carnality.

Believers have three enemies (2 Corinthians 4:4): (1)The Devil — (Colossians 1:13). To deal with the devil, we must first be born again and stay born again. Secondly, we must resist him, and thirdly, we must overcome him by the Blood of Jesus.
(2)The World — (1 John 5:19; 2 Peter 2:19). To deal with the world, we must overcome the lust of the Flesh, the Lust of and the Pride of Life.

(3)The Carnal/Corrupt Nature of Man — (1 Corinthians 2:14). Until you deal with carnality, you cannot have freedom nor please God.

Here are why we should deal with the flesh:

a. If the corrupt nature remains, 1. Satan uses it as his bait because it is a magnet for him, and 2. You will remain

attracted to worldly things. (James 1:12-15. Genesis 34:1-3).

b.Carnality hinders communication with the Holy Spirit and disrupts your fellowship with Him.

c.Carnality stops you from running the race God has set before you. (Hebrews 12:1).

d.Carnality disqualifies you from being used by God as a vessel of honour. (2 Kings 1. 2 Timothy 2:19-21).

- Practical Ways to Overcome Carnality: Create time to fellowship with God daily.
   Let the Word of God dwell in you richly. Read and Listen to His Word daily to do what He says. The food of the Holy Spirit is the Word of God.

  Meditate on His Word daily. (Joshua 1:8).

  Continually sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. These create the right environment for the Holy Spirit. (Colossians 3:16).

- Promptly acting on the instructions from the Holy Spirit. How and when you obey God matters.

**Preparing for Business Registration:** 

### Here's a step-by-step guide to registering a business with CAC:

- 1. Determine the name you want to register for your business.
- 2. Conduct a search to ensure the proposed name is available.
- Reserve the proposed name.
- 4. Carry out a newspaper publication for incorporated trustees.
- Upon approval of the name, upload the required details.
- Make the prescribed payment.
- 7. Submit the application.
- 8. Resolve queries if any is raised.
- 9. Download the documents upon approval of the registration.

Advantages of Registering a Business in Nigeria / Why should you register your business in Nigeria:

Registering a business with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) offers several advantages that ensure legal compliance, protect your business interests, and unlock various growth opportunities. Here are some of the advantages:

- · It ensures compliance with the law, as business owners are expected to register their businesses within 28 days of commencing them.
- It gives the business legal personality as a separate legal entity, except for the business name and general partnership.
- It protects your business name and prevents others from using the same name
- Safeguarding the shareholders' personal assets is generally not at risk in case of business debts or obligations except to the extent of their liability.
- It allows businesses to benefit from certain opportunities, as government tenders, contracts, and other business opportunities require that businesses be registered before they are considered.
- · It gives the business perpetual existence, so it can continue its operations even if the owners or shareholders change (this does not apply to the business name).
- It aids access to loans, grants, and other financial assistance programs offered by banks, government institutions, and investors.
- · It also facilitates financial reporting, audits, and compliance with tax obligations.
- It enhances a business's reputation and helps customers, partners, and investors build trust. Investors often prefer to invest in registered entities due to the legal framework, transparency, and limited liability protection provided.
- · It helps during account opening with a bank, as a business must be registered before a bank account can be opened.
- · It helps to easily obtain a visa and travel to any country for business
