Sunday Service Summary: STRIP TO LEAP
February 18, 2024

When athletes prepare to run, they shed layers of clothing to maximize their speed. Similarly, in the Christian journey, we are urged to rid ourselves of anything that may slow us down or hinder our progress. Hebrews 12:1-3 advises us to cast off every weight and sin that easily entangles us.

But what does this entail? Take anxiety, for instance; Philippians 4:6-7 instructs us not to be anxious about anything, indicating that anxiety is considered a sin in the New Testament era.

Besetting sins are those that persist across generations. For instance, Moses' failure to enter the Promised Land due to his anger issues echoes the temperament of his forefather Levi. Likewise, David's struggles with immorality had a profound impact on his family, mirroring the pattern set by his ancestor Judah.

How then can we rid ourselves of these burdens and sins?

1. Turn to Jesus in prayer (Matthew 11:29-30).
2. Regularly attend church.
3. Make obedience to God a top priority (Matthew 6:33).

It took Nehemiah just fifty-two days to finish the project of rebuilding the broken walls of Jerusalem. (Nehemiah 6:15). This was a project that had stalled for years. The previous generations who attempted to rebuild met with such stiff opposition and utter failure that they abandoned it. (Ezra 4:4-24).

Apart from the great advantage of the people working with Nehemiah who had a mind to work, it was also obvious that the good hand of God was upon Nehemiah and the project. Nehemiah himself acknowledged this much. (Nehemiah 2:8, 18).

Mid-Week Sermon Summary

TRAVEL LIGHT

The Bible asserts that God is Almighty, and capable of achieving all things. However, it may surprise you to know that despite His immense power, God can be constrained, and often it is by us.

An instance of God being limited is illustrated in the Gospel of Mark (Mark 6:1-6) when Jesus returned to His hometown of Nazareth. Despite expectations that His community would benefit greatly from His grace, they did not. Jesus found Himself unable to perform many miracles in His hometown; He was restricted there.

What is it then that imposes limitations upon God? It is offence. Matthew 18:7 in the Bible underscores this truth. Whenever we hold onto offence against others, it hinders God's ability to act on our behalf. Even in the Lord's Prayer, we petition, "...and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us" (Matthew 6:12). Jesus further emphasizes the importance of forgiveness in Mark 11:25, warning that if we fail to forgive others, our Heavenly Father will not forgive us.

Forgiveness is so pivotal to God that Jesus instructs in Matthew 5:23-26 that if we remember someone has something against us while presenting an offering, we must first seek reconciliation before making our offering.

Thus, we are urged to forgive all who offend us, while also striving not to be the cause of offence ourselves. By relying more on the Holy Spirit, He enables us not only to forgive those who wrong us but also to refrain from being offenders.
