Don't be discouraged or begin to murmur when this is the case. Many have lost faith because the promise of God did not happen when they expected it to or because it did not arrive as they expected.



MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY: RENEWAL PRAYERS

Renewal means to be refreshed or reinvigorated. Everybody needs to experience renewal in some form or another. The reason we sleep is so that our bodies can be rejuvenated for work.

God set the principle of rest so that we can learn to allow ourselves and our bodies to be renewed. Some need renewal because of work; others need renewal because of the burdens they carry.

Burdens are anything that does not let us move forward. Many times, these burdens are a result of depression, that is, constantly ruminating on negative thoughts.

But how can we let go of burdens and be renewed?

- 1. By fixing our minds on the Lord (Psalm 34:5).
- 2. By praying (Philippians 4:6).
- 3. By meditating on God's Word and His goodness (Isaiah 26:3).
- 4. By not keeping company with unbelievers and mockers (Psalm 1:1, Proverbs 13:20).
 5. By continuously fellowshipping with other believers (Hebrews 10:25, Psalm 96:6).
- 6. When we stop focusing on the negatives and the afflictions around us

How do we manage burdens when they come? By casting our burdens onto Jesus (Matthew 11:28-30, Psalm 55:22). How do we do this? By praying (1 Peter 5:7)

When we roll our burdens to the Lord, we have peace (Philippians 4:6-7), we start seeing the situation from God's perspective, we are strengthened with supernatural hope (Hebrews 6:19), we start thinking clearly, we show by our attitude that we're ready to be promoted.

RENEWED

One of the primary roles of the Holy Spirit in a believer's life is to convict us of our sins, but importantly, not to condemn us. John 16:8 tells us, "And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment." This conviction is a gentle nudging, a divine awareness that helps us recognise our missteps and turn back to God.

We often make mistakes that cause us to feel terrible, sometimes even leading to selfloathing. The Bible speaks about this emotional response in 2 Corinthians 7:10 (NIV): "Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death." Feeling sorrowful about our wrongdoings isn't inherently wrong. In fact, when it leads us to repentance, it can be a catalyst for positive change. The key is to learn from our mistakes and actively work towards changing our ways.

However, there's a crucial distinction between godly sorrow and prolonged, debilitating guilt. Remaining in a state of constant sorrow, repeatedly berating ourselves, and carrying an overwhelming burden of guilt is not the work of the Holy Spirit. Rather, it's often a tactic of the enemy to keep us trapped in a cycle of shame and self-condemnation. Romans 8:1 reassures us, "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus." When we find ourselves stuck in this cycle, we must recognise it is contrary to God's desire for our lives.

How can we rid ourselves of this burden of guilt? Jesus said in Matthew 11:28 that all who are weary and heavy-laden should come unto Him. We need to go to Jesus to heal us. We can go to Him in prayer, remembering that He died for our sins and has forgiven us.

Post-Registering Requirements Part 2)

After registering your business with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) in Nigeria, you must take several critical steps to ensure that your business fully complies with Nigerian laws and regulations.

Tax Obligations:

- **Obtaining a Tax Identification Number (TIN):**
 - 1. Every registered company is required to obtain a Tax Identification Number (TIN) from the Federal Inland Revenue Service (FIRS).
 - 2. The TIN is essential for tax purposes; it enables businesses to comply with tax regulations, file tax returns, and make tax payments.
 - 3. A TIN is often required to open corporate bank accounts and process other official transactions.

Value Added Tax (VAT) Registration:

1. Companies that are expected to charge VAT on goods and services must register for VAT with the FIRS.

2. VAT registration is mandatory for companies with an annual turnover exceeding a threshold set by the FIRS.

Company Income Tax:

1. Businesses are expected to file annual tax returns no later than six months after the end of their accounting year.

2. Failure to comply with tax obligations can lead to penalties and interest charges.

Withholding Tax Compliance:

Companies must deduct withholding tax at the source from payments such as rent, dividends, and royalties and remit these to the FIRS.

Personal Income Tax for Employees:

Employers are also responsible for deducting personal income tax from their employee's salaries and remitting it to the relevant state tax authorities.
