## SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY: SEVEN PILLARS OF LEADERSHIP

The second pillar of leadership is wisdom. The Bible calls wisdom the principal thing and then admonishes us to get wisdom (Proverbs 4:7). The Bible also tells us where wisdom begins: fearing God (Proverbs 9:10). It is possible to be saved and not wise. How so? When we don't look into the Word of God and are careful to do it, we are considered foolish.

2 Timothy 3:15 shows us how the scripture was written by the Inspiration of God and the reasons why it is profitable. When we are not filled with God's Word and don't find out what God's way is concerning any situation, we're being foolish.

God's intention and purpose is to demonstrate His wisdom through His children to even spiritual forces (Ephesians 3:10). People will not come to the demonstration of power but wisdom. This is exactly what happened in the case of King Solomon.

In the last days, the Bible records that people will come to Zion, which is the church, to be taught the ways of God - the ways of God are true wisdom (Isaiah 2:1-3). Wisdom contains doctrine, a teaching system; it contains reproof, correction and instruction in righteousness. Wisdom is only gotten from and by scriptures.

The third pillar of leadership is righteousness. Righteousness simply means doing things that please God.

Righteousness can be defined as three things:

1. As a free gift from God.
2. It is a practice, a way of living.
3. It is a person's, organisation's, business' or state's policy

There are 3 things righteousness does when you have it:

1. It exalts - a person, a group or even a country (Proverbs 14:34).
2. It preserves (Proverbs 11:4, Genesis 18:23-25, Isaiah 38:1-5).
3. It procures favour (Genesis 37-50, Luke 1:28).

When you aim to please God in all you do, God will entrust His plans to you as He did Joseph, the son of Israel, and Mary, the mother of Jesus.

## MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY:

### SEVEN PILLARS OF LEADERSHIP

**PILLAR 4: RESPONSIBILITY:** Responsibility is the measure of one's maturity. Anyone who doesn't want to take charge cannot be a leader. The scope of your leadership is directly related to the scope of responsibilities you're able and willing to shoulder. Responsibility is not necessarily by age. At 17, David was responsible for his father's sheep (1 Samuel 17:34-35, Psalm 78:70-71), and God recognised him from where he was and lifted him from there.

**PILLAR 5: RESOURCEFULNESS:** Resourcefulness refers to finding quick and clever ways to overcome difficulties and solve problems using available resources. You can be resourceful with your time, talents and treasure. This means you can take what's ordinary and make it extraordinary.

There are 4 areas you must be resourceful:  
1. Spiritually (Hebrews 6:12). 2. Mentally. 3. Emotionally. 4. Physically.

**PILLAR 6: RELATIONSHIP:** The first relationship you must have and be consistent with is your personal and intimate relationship with God (John 17:3). You can't know God except by revelation and this revelation comes from Jesus (Matthew 11:27).

There are four levels of knowledge when it comes to relationships. (1) is the knowledge of God. It is as we know Him that we discover ourselves. If we don't know Him, we might never know what our purpose is, and it might be the very thing we are trying to destroy that's our purpose (Galatians 1:13-16). The only thing we're permitted to boast in, is our relationship with God (Jeremiah 9: 23-24). (2) The knowledge of ourselves. We can only know ourselves when we know God. The more we know God (our manufacturer), the more we know ourselves through His Word (our manual). (3) Our relationship with people. Our knowledge of God also empowers and equips us to relate with people and be a blessing to them. (4) The knowledge of the laws of life (Galatians 6:7).

**PILLAR 7: RICHES:** (Deuteronomy 28:1-2,13; Proverbs 22:7). To be rich means to have a full supply of all your needs (2 Corinthians 8:9, 9:8, Ecclesiastes 11:14-16).

#### How do we enter into riches:

By the knowledge of what Christ has done for us (Galatians 3:13-14, 26-29, Genesis 24:1, 13:2). Do what Abraham did if you want to be rich, and what did he do?

1. He believed everything God told him; he was a man of faith and always obeyed God promptly. 2. He never withheld anything from God.



**Righteousness...**

We have learnt about the seven pillars of leadership. One of the pillars is righteousness. Righteousness defined simply is pleasing God. Apart from the fact that it is a free gift of God through Jesus, it is also a way of life, a practice.

The world has laid out so many ways and paths to achieving things, but God also has His pattern, and it's laid out in the scriptures.

Whenever, we are to make decisions or take action over any matter, our leading thought should be to please God.

**Thrive: Fundamentals of Pre-Martial Relationship**

God has His way of getting married and doing marriage. God has His system of doing things which are in sharp contrast to the way the world does things. In Ephesians 3:10 we see that God wants to use us to showcase His wisdom to principalities and powers - the unforeseen powers. Part of this wisdom is the righteousness we have in Christ Jesus and the way we live. If the way we live does not please God, then we are embarrassing Him.

There are several benefits to being righteous as stipulated by scripture and they are:

1. It preserves (Proverbs 11:4).
2. It exalts (Proverbs 14:34).
3. It procure favour (Luke 1:28).

**BENEFITS (3): Prayer and Conflict Resolution in Marriage: A Biblical Perspective... (1)**

**The Foundation of Prayer in Conflict Resolution:** When couples pray together during times of conflict, they invite God's presence into their disagreements. This spiritual practice transforms how they approach and resolve conflicts. As Ephesians 4:32 beautifully instructs, "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."

**The Power of Humility in Prayer:**

**Biblical Principles for Conflict Resolution Through Prayer:**

**1. Approach Conflicts with Love**

"Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins" (1 Peter 4:8). When couples pray together, they remind themselves of God's love and are better equipped to:

- Show patience with each other.

- Respond with kindness
- Look beyond immediate frustrations
