SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY: THE JOY FACTOR (PART 1)

Joy means gladness of heart, independent of circumstances and feelings. It should not be confused with happiness which is dependent on circumstances and feelings.

Even when we do righteously, we're expected to do it rejoicing and not grudgingly if we want to experience the help of God (Isaiah 64:5; Philippians 2:14). It provokes God when we don't serve Him with joy and gladness of heart. It even attracts curses (Deuteronomy 28:47-48).

Joyful people see good in every circumstance, even very painful circumstances. We are not joyful because everything is okay; we're joyful because even the things that are not okay work out for our good.

- There are four areas in which we must not lose our joy:

 1. Psalm 51:12: The Joy of our salvation. When we initially got bornagain, there was a joy we experienced. Like David, we must cry out to God for restoration if we have lost it.

 2. Hebrews 11:6, 1 Peter 1:8, Romans 4:19-20: Faith. Any faith we have that is not accompanied by Joy is fake. Faith is the belief that we have received, and if we believe that we've received, then we should be full of joy. The more joyful we are, the more our strength increases (Nehemiah 8:10).
 - 3. Romans 14:17, Proverbs 15:15: Joy is the manifestation of the kingdom of God. Joy in the Holy Ghost activates the supernatural in our lives.

 4. Galatians 5:22: Joy is a fruit of the Holy Spirit.

Joy indicates how healthy, strong, and mature we are spiritually. If we're easily depressed, agitated, or worried about circumstances around us, we lack joy. If we want to experience the ministry of angels, we must always be joyful. Angels gravitate towards joyful people.



THE JOY FACTOR (PART 2)

Joy is extremely important in everyone's life. Anything that succeeds in stealing your joy has succeeded in stealing your life. This is why we hear of people who have achieved much 'success' in life still taking their lives.

Joy can be measured. In several parts of the Bible, God clearly stated how He wants the joy in His children to be full (John 15:11, 16:24, 1 John 1:4, 2 John 1:12). It is with joy that we draw water from the wells of Salvation (Isaiah 12:3). Even with faith, you still need joy to receive what you desire. You must diligently guard joy in your heart and resist everything that wants to take it out vehemently.

Where do we go to get the fullness of Joy? Psalm 16 vs 11. When you come consciously, intentionally into God's presence, you will have fullness of joy. You can set the atmosphere for God's presence in your heart and home. Praise God 24hrs, Worship God. Deliberately cultivate God's presence.

God wants our joy to be full to experience more of His blessings. What other reasons should we be joyful:

- 1. Joy opens us up to the revelation of God and divine direction (Psalm 48:17).
- 2. All things thrive under the atmosphere of joy (Joel 1:12).
- 3. Joy makes us attractive (2 Corinthians 2:14-15).

4. We experience abundance when we are joyful (Psalm 65:11, 67:5-7).
