- 3. It is God's will for us to have eternal life.





Mid-Week Sermon THE RIGHTEOUS QUOTA

The concept of righteousness encompasses both quantity and quality. When God revealed the future to Abraham regarding his descendants and the land they would inherit, He noted that the sins of the people were not yet complete, indicating that the land couldn't be possessed at that time (Genesis 15:16).

Before passing judgment on any nation, God provides warnings repeatedly. There exists a requirement for righteous individuals before God executes judgment, as seen in the case of Sodom and Gomorrah's destruction (Genesis 18:17-33).

Understanding the righteous quota involves four key pillars:

1. God actively seeks righteousness on earth (Isaiah 26:8).

2. Righteousness serves as a deterrent to God's judgment (Genesis 7:1, Ezekiel 18:21–23, Jonah 3:1-10).

3. The righteous act as the preserving salt of the earth (2 Corinthians 2:14, Matthew 5:13).

4. The quality and consistency of one's righteousness are essential for enduring until the end (Matthew 10:22, 2 Peter 2:4-7).

In conclusion, righteousness is not only a matter of quantity but also of quality and consistency. The presence of righteousness tempers god's judgment, and it is through righteousness that individuals are preserved and endure. Therefore, understanding and upholding righteousness is crucial in navigating God's divine plans and judgments.
