SUNDAY SERVICE SUMMARY: HE RESTORES MY SOUL

Psalm 23:3 shows us that God will lead us in the paths of righteousness, and He does it so that we can live profitable lives (Isaiah 48:17).

God's guidance is contingent upon our restoration. A soul in distress is unable to perceive God's voice. Therefore, God leads us away from the clamour, creating a space for His communication (Hosea 2:14-15). The first step in healing a distressed soul is to instil hope.

What are the signs of a distressed soul?

1. Fear and Lack of control of your emotions.
2. Affliction of the soul (Psalm 119:67).
3. Bloated sense of importance.
4. Depression and suicidal thoughts.
5. Lack of clarity and direction.
6. Constant tiredness.

God restores the distress of the soul by leading us through green pastures, which represent His Word (Psalm 19:7).

Why does God heal the distress of the soul?

1. So we can fellowship with Him.
2. So that He can lead us (Proverbs 14:12).
3. So He can teach us to profit (Isaiah 48:17).
4. So that we can know His good, acceptable and perfect will for us (Romans 12: 2).
5. So that He can show us His glorious future (Jeremiah 33:3).
6. So that He can give us a glorious end.

God needs to lead us so we don't go down the road of destruction (Proverbs 14:12).

MIDWEEK SERVICE SUMMARY: Cultivating A Healthy & Prosperous Soul!

To cultivate means to develop, improve, and protect. Thus, we are to develop, improve, and protect all the parts that make up our souls—our minds, emotions, will, conscience, and memory—so that our souls can be healthy. Healthy means to be in sound health and prosperous means wealthy.

The instrument of cultivating a healthy and prosperous soul is the Word of God (Psalm 19:17).

Here is how:

- Cultivate your Mind – the engine of our soul and the thinking faculty (Romans 12:2)
What are the things in our minds that the Word of God deals with? 2 Corinthians 10:5 shows us these things. They are:
 - a. Strongholds - these are belief systems we have that are contrary to God's Word.
 - b. Imaginations - Heresies, false arguments, etc.
- (1 Peter 5: 5-6. 1 Corinthians 2:16).
- Cultivate your Emotions – be sober-minded (Philippians 4:5).
- Cultivate your Will – the decision part of your soul. (Jeremiah 1:5. 33:5).
- Cultivate your Conscience the moral part of your soul. (1 Timothy 1:19).
- Cultivate your Memory – by shutting out bad and negative memories. (Isaiah 43:25-26).

There are five signs of a cultivated soul. A cultivated soul is:

- Always hopeful - Hope is the anchor of a cultivated soul (Romans 8:24).
- Always peaceful - Peace is the umpire of a cultivated soul (1 Thessalonians 5:23, Isaiah 55:12).
- Always Meek - Meekness is the attitude of a cultivated. It is important to be meek because:
 - i. God will fight your battles.
 - ii. God will lead and guide you (Psalm 25:9).
 - iii. You will inherit the earth (Matthew 5:5).
- Always Quiet - Quietness is the state of a cultivated soul (1 Peter 3:4).
- Always Joyful - Joy is the passion of a cultivated soul (1 Thessalonians 5:16, Philippians 4:4).
